I JUNE 2013 ADDENDUM TO GREATER GOLDEN HORSESHOE GROWTH FORECASTS TO 2041

The technical report *Greater Golden Horseshoe Growth Forecasts to 2041* (GGH *Forecasts to 2041*) was released in November 2012 at the same time as the Ontario Ministry of Infrastructure's release of a proposed amendment to the *Growth Plan for the Greater Golden Horseshoe* (Proposed Amendment 2). Proposed Amendment 2 proposed to update and extend the time horizon of the growth forecasts for single- and upper-tier municipalities in the Greater Golden Horseshoe (GGH) shown in Schedule 3 of the *Growth Plan*.

Following consultation and review of the proposed amendment, revisions have been made to the growth forecasts. The revisions are limited in scope, and arise from changes to the outlook for the Region of Waterloo and County of Wellington. However, due to the integrated structure of the forecasts the nature of the revisions affects the forecasts for other areas in the western part of the GGH.

The revised forecast results for the entire GGH are provided in a new version of *Appendix B: Detailed Forecast Results*, dated June 2013, attached to this addendum and they replace those in the *GGH Forecasts to 2041* report.

The method for distributing population growth to single- and upper-tier municipalities within the GGH, as described on pp. 24-25 of the *GGH Forecasts to 2041*, still applies to the forecast revisions. One aspect of the distribution method was the environmental and infrastructure capacity of municipalities to accommodate growth. In this respect, the report stated:

Consistent with the Provincial economic outlook, it is generally assumed that the forecast housing growth will be supported by government investments in infrastructure. In no jurisdiction is infrastructure required for development considered to be an impediment to growth. (p.25)

...

Environmental constraints that limit the ability to provide long-term water and wastewater services to accommodate growth have been assumed in the Region of Waterloo, Wellington County, Guelph and Dufferin County. In these areas headwaters, groundwater, and assimilative capacity are understood to be significant constraints. Wellington and Guelph are assumed to build out their current plans by the 2030s and then only provide for limited infill growth thereafter. In Dufferin a relatively slow rate of growth is assumed recognising the environmental constraints and the restriction that Orangeville, where most of Dufferin's growth has occurred in the past, cannot expand further. (p.25)

The environmental constraints referred to above were addressed in the forecast by assuming that growth that might otherwise have occurred in constrained areas would occur in communities adjacent or near to these areas. Specifically, the County of Brant, Haldimand County, City of Brantford, Region of Halton, Region of Peel, City of Hamilton, and the Region of Niagara were all forecast to accommodate more growth, mainly after 2031, than they otherwise would have, owing to environmental constraints in the Region of Waterloo, County of Wellington, City of Guelph, and Dufferin County.

Feedback received by the Ministry of Infrastructure from consultation on Proposed Amendment 2 indicates that environmental constraints on growth in the Region of Waterloo and County of Wellington (mainly in the form of water and sewer servicing capacity) are less severe than had been assumed in the November 2012 GGH *Forecasts to 2041* report. As a result the forecasts have been revised so that forecasts for the Waterloo and Wellington are slightly higher than shown in that report. It is noted that, notwithstanding the adjustment, the forecasts for these municipalities continue to be premised on environmental constraints being a limiting factor on growth, albeit to a lesser degree than originally anticipated.

The effects of the environmental constraints of forecasts for the City of Guelph and County of Dufferin assumed in the November 2012 report remain unchanged.

To accommodate higher growth in Waterloo and Wellington the growth distribution to surrounding areas has been revised based on the distribution method and assumptions set out in the November 2012 report. Tables A-1 and A-2 show effects of the changes to the population and employment forecasts to 2041.

All other forecasting assumptions remain as documented in the November 2012 Technical Report, including those that were made consistent with the Ontario Ministry of Finance's Spring 2012 Ontario Population Projections Update such as fertility rates, mortality rates, immigration, emigration, change in non-permanent residents, and inter-provincial migration.
